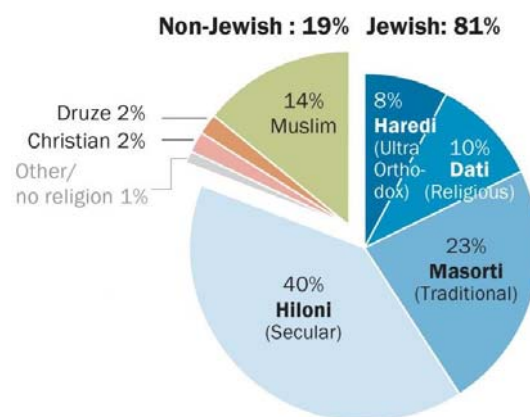

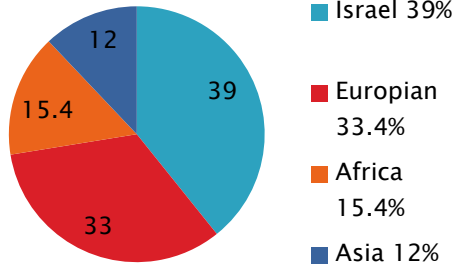
### Israel Demographics – Religion

## Israeli Cinema Law – Diversity

- ▶ “The purpose of the support is to enable expression of the cultural diversity in Israeli society, of the different views in it, and its different values”
- ▶ “The reader composition will reflect a proper representation for Women”
- ▶ “The readers will reflect a proper representation of the geographical, social and cultural periphery in Israel”

## The Rabinovich Foundation– Diversity in readers, 2016

- ▶ In Full Length Feature Films:
  - 8 of 17 readers – Women
  - 15 of 17 readers – geographical, social and cultural periphery
- ▶ In Documentary Films:
  - 7 of 11 readers – Women
  - 9 of 11 readers – geographical, social and cultural periphery
