## 2016 Lighting Technicians' Pay Increase

The below sets out the Summary of Agreement reached between Pact and BECTU as approved by a ballot of lighting technicians on January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2016

- Shooting technicians £1575 per week, rigging £1365 per week (shooting technicians £315 per day, rigging £273 per day)
  - (The above rate is a total increase of 8.5% on the last negotiated pay increase of £1450/£1250 for weekly engagement of shooting and rigging technicians respectively).
- Above rate applies to engagements on Major Motion Pictures
- Implementation date: 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016 for all engagement of lighting technicians (shooting and rigging) on Major Motion Pictures
- Current working practice/hours to remain as is. Any changes to be discussed at next review meeting
- Next review meeting: end of Sept/early Oct 2016 (agenda to be determined, but to include future pay increases/hours of work)
